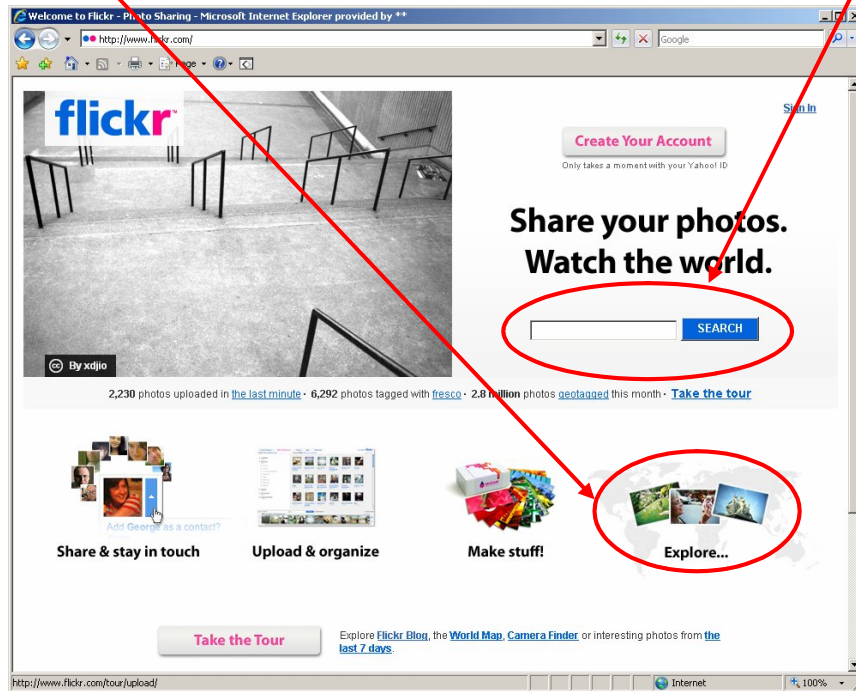


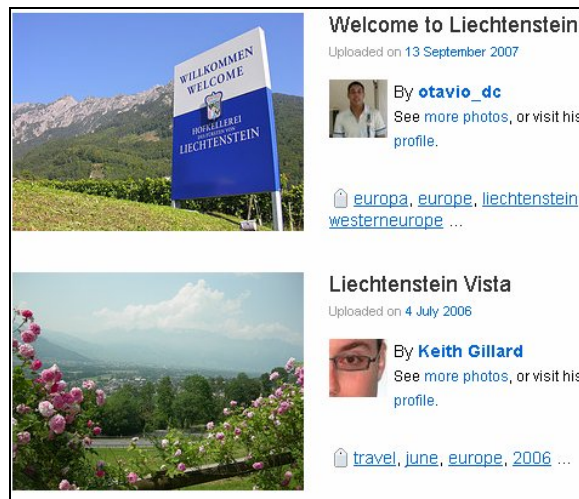
Getting photos from flickr to your blog

Finding a photo

Searching flickr is fairly easy. Go to www.flickr.com and type a term in the search box. You can also browse flickr by clicking the Explore... option.

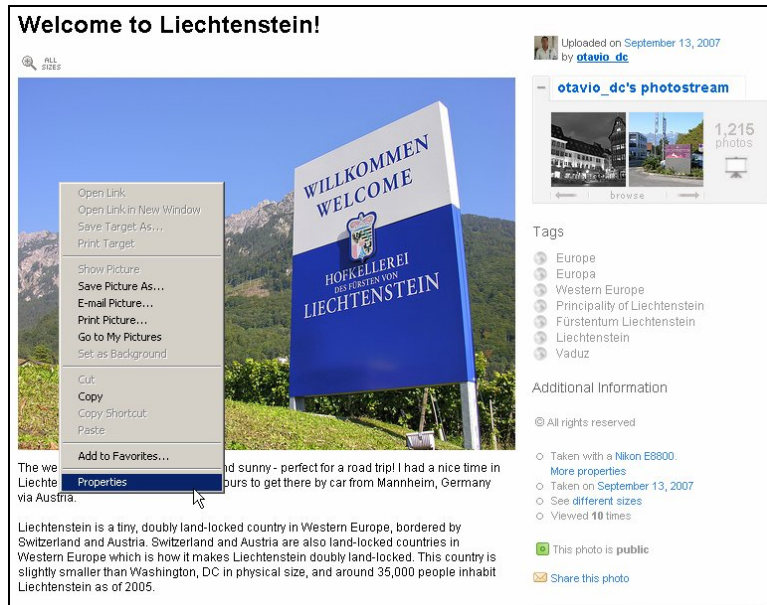


Find a picture you like and click on it.

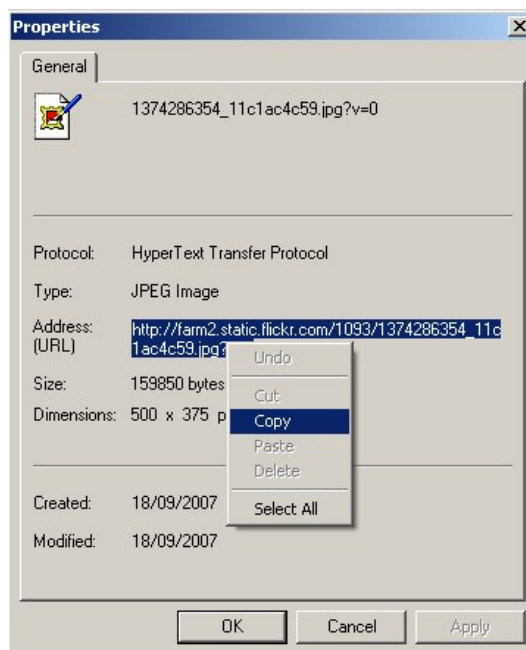


Once you can view the photo, there are a number of ways to add it to your blog. If you do NOT have a flickr account then you can either save the photo to your computer and upload it to your blog or link it using the method listed below.

First, right click on the picture and choose Properties.



Highlight the Address (URL) part of the properties, right click and choose 'Copy'

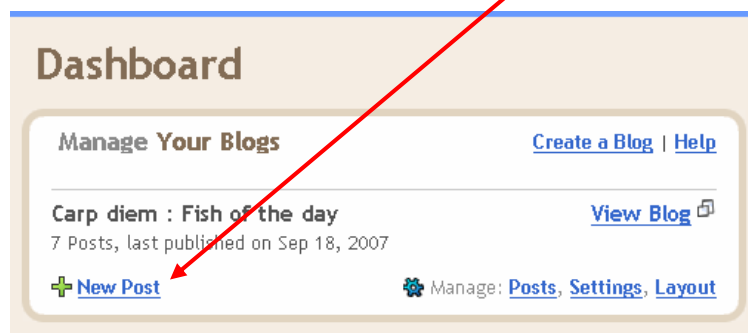

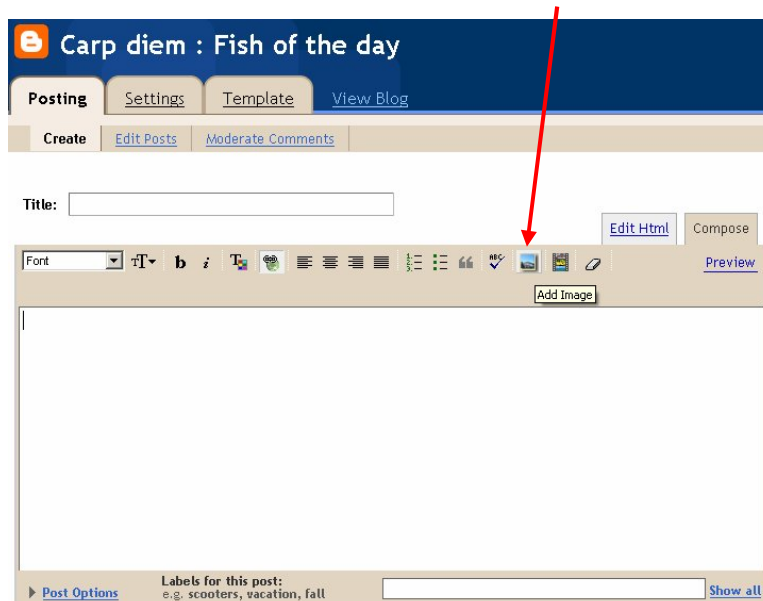
Next, go to www.blogger.com and log in to your blog (type your work email address and the password you've used to create your blog in the top right-hand corner).



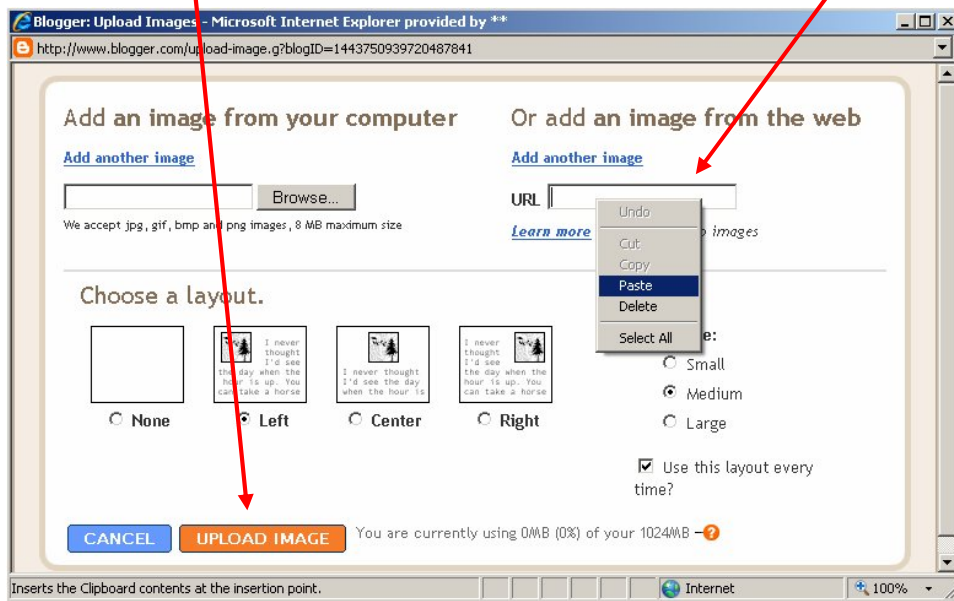
On the Dashboard (at the top of the page), click on 'New Post'.



This will allow you to create a new post. Click on the 'Add Image' button.



In the URL area of the screen, right click your mouse and select 'Paste'. Once this is done, click the 'Upload Image' button.



Once it has finished loading, you will receive a message to tell you your image has been added to the blog.
